The Salvation Army were able to assist with bedding, towels and other household items to help tide them over until the insurance claim was processed. As well as enough food for a Christmas dinner and 5 presents for each child. The sheer relief of the face of Mum and Dad was heart-warming, to be able to help turn a disastrous Christmas into one which could be enjoyed was a blessing, and something that your generosity contributed to directly.
